Explore the origins of the Templars History throughout the founder's life of the mythical order: Hugues de Payns.



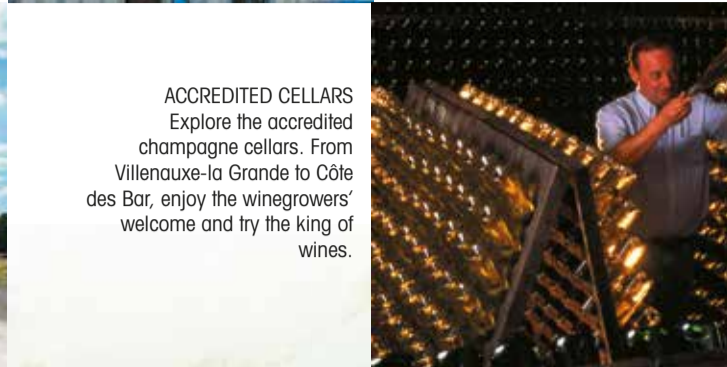
MARNAY-SUR-SEINE BOTANICAL GARDEN

Contemporary stained glass windows by David Tremlett



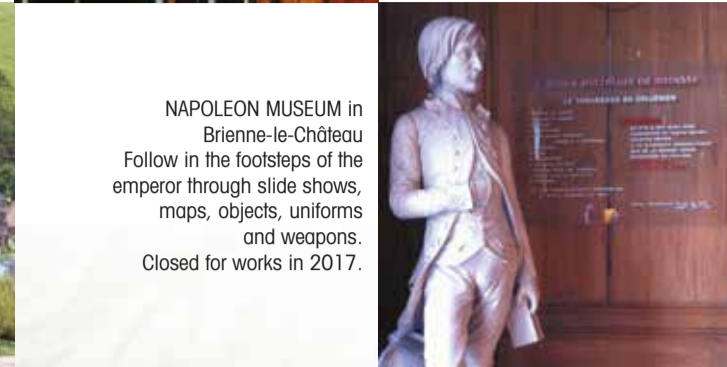
VALUX CASTLE in Fouchères

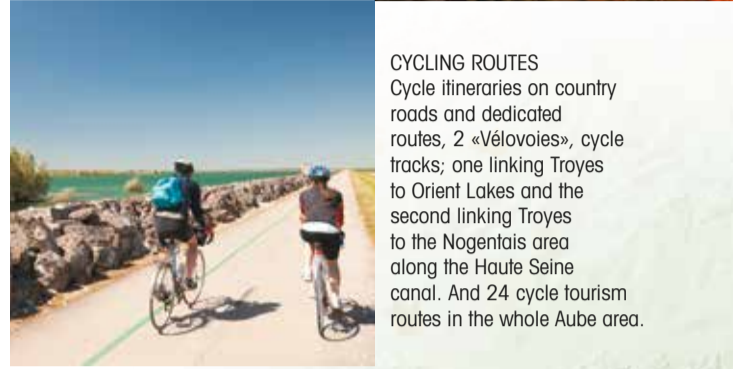
REMARKABLE CHURCHES Aube, a remarkable religious heritage: over 100 listed churches and abbeys, the largest body of stained glass windows in France ...

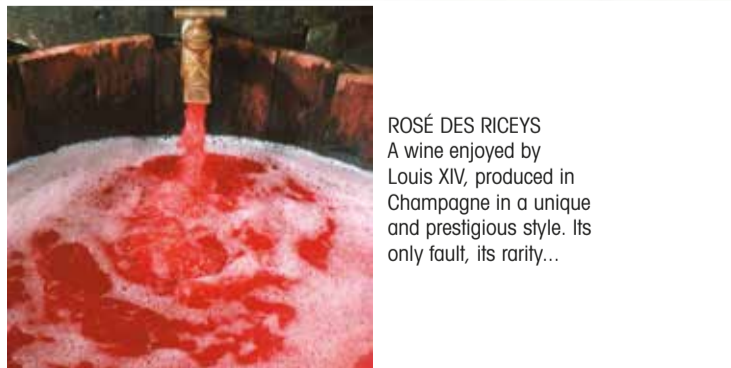

Explore the Camille Claudel's world, a remarkable and very talented sculptor.



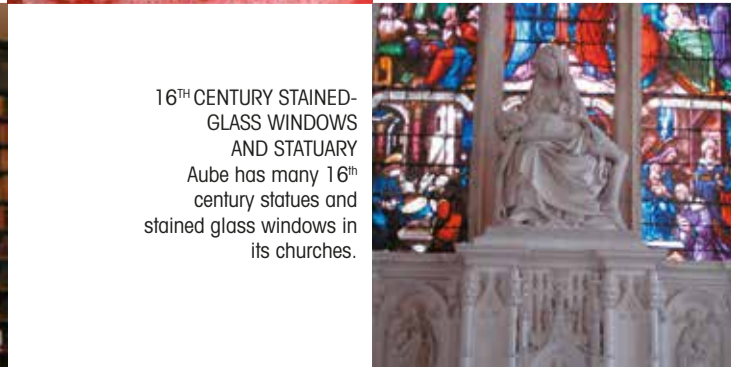
CHAOURCE CHEESE
Chaource, a cheese with a Protected Designation of Origin, has witnessed the passing centuries thanks to a cheese tradition rooted in its terroir.



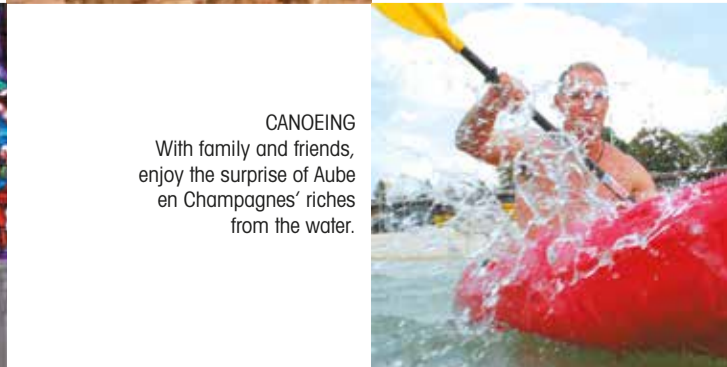
BLU PLATEAU
A magnificent viewpoint overlooking the Champagne vineyard with a viewpoint indicator and picnic area.



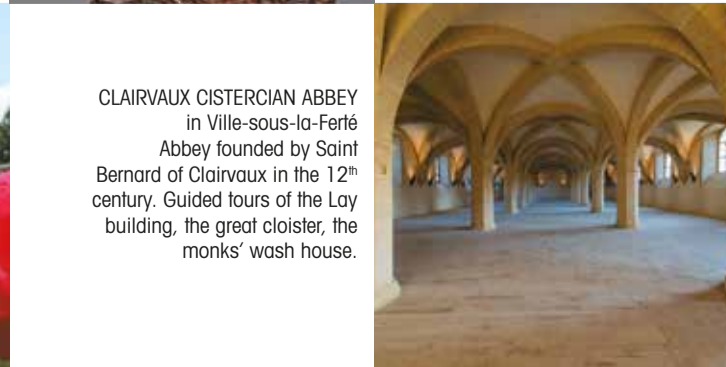
APOTHECARY'S MUSEUM in Troyes
