



d'Estree.




PAYS D'OTHE CIDER

windows by David Tremlett




VAUX CASTLE

France ...




NAPOLEON MUSEUM in

Reopening end of 2017




**AUBE EN CHAMPAGNE

routes in the whole Aube area.




BRAND CENTRES

yesterday, milliner's shop.




CAMILLE CLAUDEL MUSEUM

painter Boeshwillwald.




CHAOURCE CHEESE

in its terroir.




BLU PLATEAU

18th century setting.




**16TH CENTURY STAINED-
