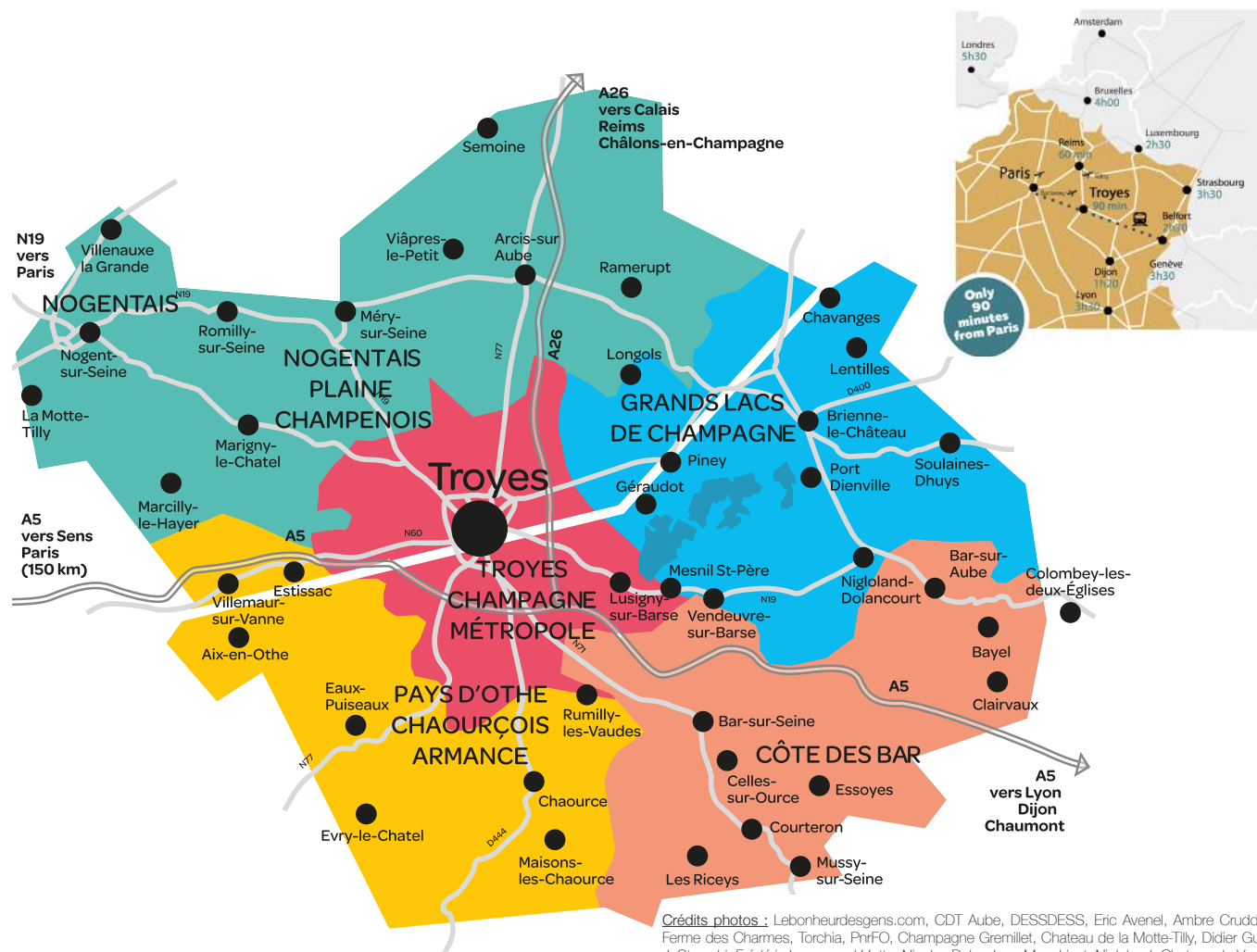

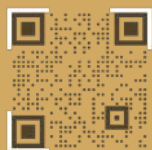

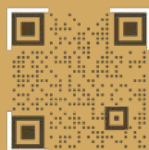

THE PRESTIGE OF CHAMPAGNE AND OF CRYSTAL

OENOTOURISM & GASTRONOMY

1 day Start : 9.00 am - End : 5.45 pm

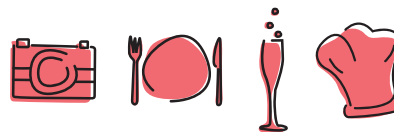

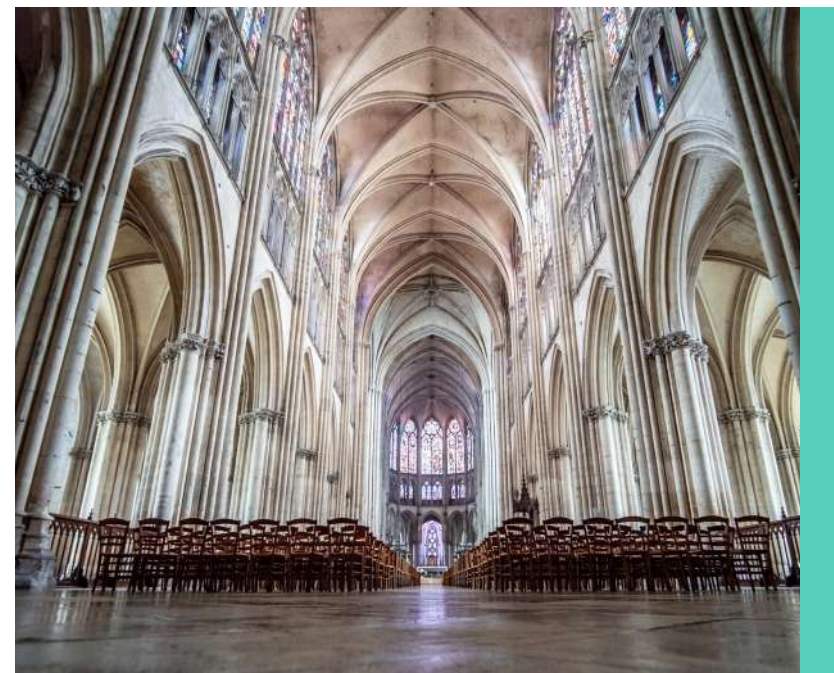

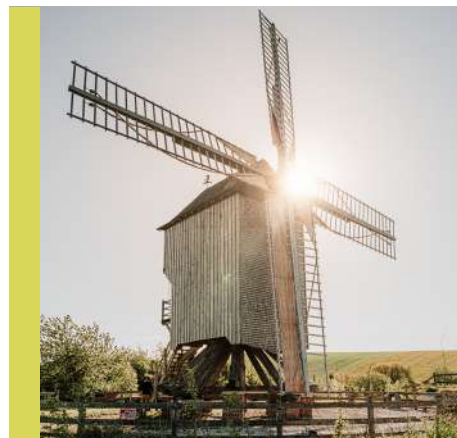

This little-known piece of history is now being revisited for the 6th centenary of the «Shameful Treaty of Troyes», signed at Troyes Cathedral. A visit to «**Le Cellier St-Pierre**» and its distillery nestled at the foot of the cathedral, followed by a tasting of Troyes sloe gin «**Prunelle de Troyes**». Lunch of a local produce.

Afternoon

A visit to the « Two Crowns, One King: **Troyes in 1420** » exhibition. For the 6th centenary of the Treaty of Troyes, the Department of Aube wishes to revisit this little-known piece of history through a major exhibition involving nearly 180 prestigious documents (works of art, ornate manuscripts, archaeological and military objects, and archival documents) lent by national and international institutions.

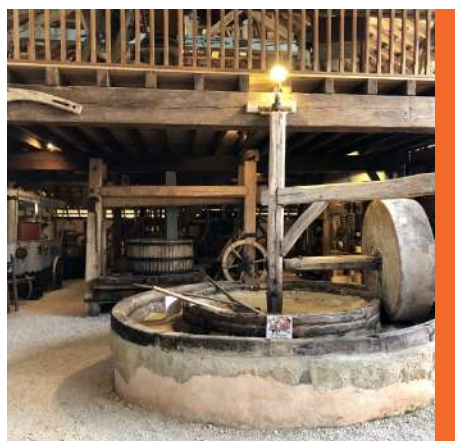

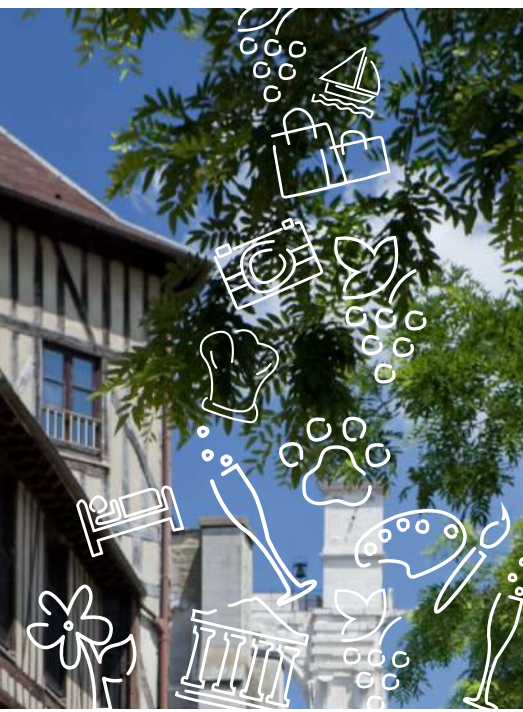

Visit to the **Church of Longsols**. This **timber frame church** was built in the 15th century. You'll discover its nave consisting of four bays, its uniquely styled transept and choir, and its slate-covered central spire.

Dinner and night in your *** hotel.

Day 3

MORNING

You will visit the **Musée de Fromage** (Museum of Cheese) followed by a tasting of Chaource cheese, then you will experience the **fromagerie of Mussy**, the department's last artisanal cheese shop, and partake in a cheese tasting. Lunch of a local produce.

AFTERNOON

After a walk through **the Priory gardens**, head to Les Riceys, its vineyards, its cadoles (traditional stone shelters), its 3 churches, 3 controlled origin appellations (including the famous Les Riceys rosé to taste) and its château with its classical park and garden.



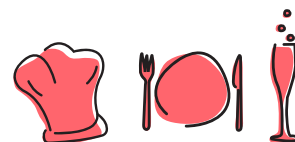

Guided tour of **Moulin de Saint-Martin** brewery. Mahaut, a young creator of beers, invites you to discover her products and share her passion.

Lunch of a local produce.

AFTERNOON

Visit to **La Petite Biscuiterie** in Maizières-la-Grande-Paroisse. Here you can sample maiziérons and other biscuits. Head to Troyes to visit «Le Cellier St-Pierre» and its distillery nestled at the foot of the cathedral, followed by a tasting of Troyes sloe gin «**Prunelle de Troyes**».

Dinner and night in your *** hotel.

Day 2

MORNING

Guided tour of **Troyes**, historic capital of Champagne. During the visit you will discover **colorful timber frame houses**, cobble streets, and numerous churches hiding magnificent treasures such as stained glass windows that tell stories. Head to La Côte des Bar to have **lunch matched with champagne**.

AFTERNOON

After a guided tour of the «**farm of the Mill**» (Goat husbandry, cheese making, and saffron production) and a **cheese tasting**, you will end the day with a visit to a **Champagne cellar** and a **Rosé des Riceys wine tasting**.

Dinner and night in your *** hotel.

Day 3

MORNING

Visit a **cheese dairy** and discover traditionally made (handladled) **Chaource cheese** and other specialities : Délice de Mussy, Lysée Champagne-Ardenne... You will then discover a **mushroom farm**, its mushroom production, and their cooked products such as mushroom fondue with Chaource cheese. Lunch at ferme d'Hotte.

AFTERNOON

In the heart of Pays d'Othe, find out everything there is to know about **apples** from an educational point of view via film, an exhibition, a trip in a **little train** and a visit to the shop. Onward in the direction of **Villemaure-sur-Vanne** to discover its **collegiate church**, known for its wood-covered steeple and even more for its rood screen made of carved wood, dating from 1521. Finally enjoy a visit to the «Domaine du Moulin d'Eguebau» **salmon farm** before dinner on site. Dinner and night in your *** hotel.

Day 4

MORNING

Explore the welcoming environment of «**Marché des Halles de Troyes**», where you can purchase delicacies such as Pascal Caffet pastries and chocolates and local products from the Aube region, including andouillette, cheeses, and Champagne. Guided tour of the **Escargotière des Lacs**, a snail farm which produces around 300,000 «Big Grey» snails before a visit of the timber frame church of Longsols.

Lunch of a local produce.

AFTERNOON

To finish off this gastronomical adventure, a visit to the **Champ-sur-Barse cheese producer**. Champ Sur Barse is a farm cheese shaped using a ladle. It is eaten in many forms (strained, plain, and with herbs) and the refining process allows different flavours to be developed.

CULTURE DISCOVERY

Rendez-vous at **Bayel** for a glass-blowing demonstration followed by a free visit to the Crystal Museum. Lunch in the heart of Clairvaux Abbey.

AFTERNOON

Immersion into the ecclesiastical world of **Clairvaux Abbey** founded in the XII century by Saint Bernard, a French masterpiece of monastic architecture transformed into a prison by Napoleon. Discovery of various buildings re-tracing the site's history: the splendid building of the converts with its cellar and dormitory (XII century), the Barn from the XVI century, the hostelry of the Ladies and the classic Grand Convent from the XVIII century.

You will finish with a visit to a **Cistercian Champagne cellar**, a former annexe of the abbey followed by a **champagne tasting**.

Dinner and night in your *** hotel.

Day 2

MORNING

Guided tour of **Troyes**, historic capital of Champagne. During the visit you will discover colorful timber frame houses, cobbled streets, and numerous churches hiding magnificent treasures such as stained glass windows that tell stories.

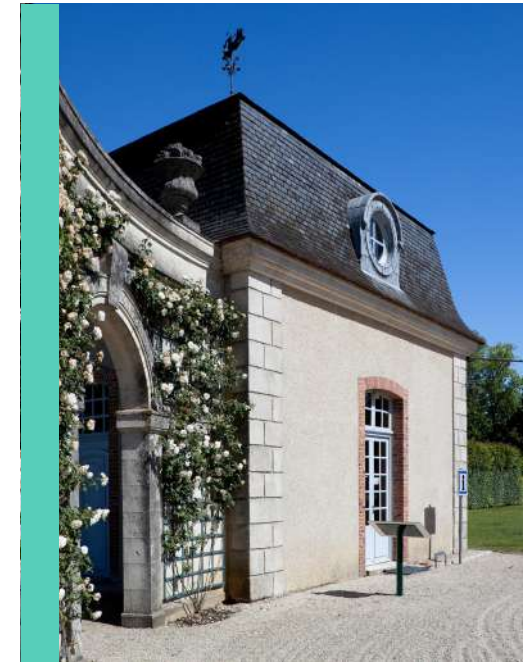
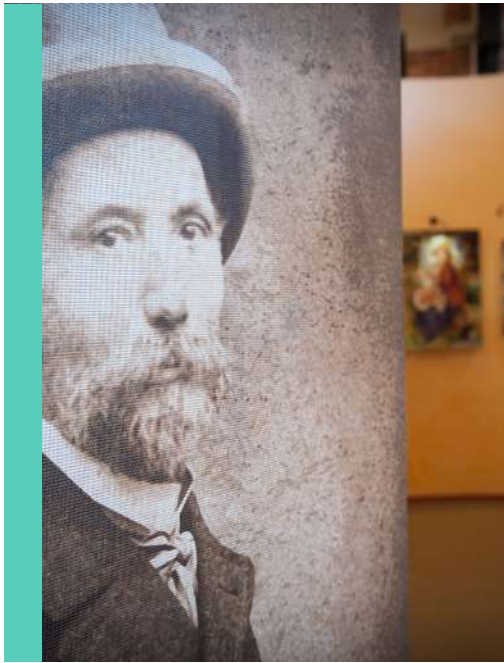

Free visit of the **St Peter St Paul Cathedral** of Troyes before a guided visit of the **St-Loup Museum**, a museum of fine arts and archaeology situated in the Saint-Loup abbey, built in the XVII century. You continue with a visit to the **Cellier St Pierre** and its distillery nestled at the foot of the cathedral followed by a tasting of the **Prunelle de Troyes** (the Pearl, Jewel of Troye) in the newly restored barn from the XIII century.

Dinner and night in your *** hotel.





Day 3

MORNING

From the space dedicated to the celebrated family of artists to the painter's studio where the natural light inspired many of his paintings, you will walk in the footsteps of the **great master of Impressionism**. His family house opens its doors to you. From among the reconstructed and original works displayed in the case in the dining room, the world of the peasant life from the start of the XX century is revealed to you, when Renoir came to Champagne to live a peasant's lifestyle. Lunch of a local produce.

AFTERNOON

Visit to the **champagne cellar**, you will taste the Renoir champagne vintage and learn why it is associated with a work by Pierre Auguste Renoir. You will finish the day with A visit of the **Templar Commandery of Avasseur**, a place of Templar heritage exceptional for its authenticity. The Gothic Chapel remains intact. Dinner and night in your *** hotel.

Day 4

MORNING

Visit of the **Napoleon museum** which takes you on a journey of the epic imperial story, the early years and the reformatory work of Napoleon Bonaparte. Lunch of a local produce.

AFTERNOON

Visit to the Church of Longsols. This **timber frame church** was built in the 15th century. You'll discover its nave consisting of four bays, its uniquely styled transept and choir, and its slate-covered central spire ; before entering a **post windmill** to explore flour milling and extend your visit with a walk through the **ancient gardens** and the 15th **century tithe barn**. Dinner and night in your *** hotel.

Day 5

MORNING

Understanding the context in which the artist **Camille Claudel** was formed, developed and had to make her mark, this is the challenge of this visit to the museum, in the town where as an adolescent, Camille Claudel met the sculptor Alfred Boucher in 1874. Lunch in the historic center of Nogent-Sur-Seine.

AFTERNOON

Go back in time to the 18th century in the corridors of **Motte Tilly Château** and its French gardens (60 hectares), labelled « Jardin remarquable ».



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
