





The cuisine on offer is wholesome and tasty with organic garden vegetables and local meats. Then end your day with a visit to a pioneering **biodynamic estate**. An original day that will comfort or reconcile you with our beautiful nature.

### **GENTLE MOBILITY IN THE MARNE**

Last: 2 days Distance: 50 km Valid: all year round

Based on 10 people From € 285 / person

You begin your stay in **Reims**, greeted by a guide at Reims-centre station for a guided walking tour, including the cathedral (UNESCO). After a visit to a Champagne House and a tasting of a cuvée, go by foot to the restaurant and check into your \*\*\* hotel in the city center. Free time in the «Cité des Sacres», followed by dinner on your own. On next day, departure by TER for Epernay through the vineyards and the Parc Naturel Régional de la Montagne de Reims. Arrival in Epernay, departure on foot to pick up the bikes, then a ride along the Véloroute de la Vallée de la Marne along the canal to Aÿ-Champagne (Unesco). Visit and tasting winemaker. After a guick champagne lunch, visit Pressoria and tasting of 2 champagnes. Return to Epernay and bike drop-off, then departure by train.

In the afternoon, your guide will show you the rich architectural of the **Avenue** de Champagne, the heart of Épernay. You admire the city's rooftops from the air, 360° view of the vineyards from the tethered balloon. Then enjoy a flute of champagne in a **Champagne House** on the Avenue, before concluding your sparkling day with an educational and immersive tour of Champagne Nicolas Feuillatte, accompanied by a tasting session.





# HISTORICAL AND GOURMET ESCAPADE IN REIMS

Last: 1 day Distance: 10 km Based on 10 people (from 10 to 30 people) From € 232.50 / person

Valid: On request all year round (except Saturdays and Sundays)

The day gets off to a gentle start with a visit to the cookie factory that produces the famous **"Biscuit rose de Reims"**. The famous **Pommery Champagne House** then welcomes you for a guided tour of its cellars including magnificent «crayères» (impressive shafts dug into the chalk in Gallo-Roman times), followed by a tasting of 2 flutes of champagne.

Then, a pleasant lunch awaits you in a **friendly brasserie** in the centerof Reims. In the afternoon, accompanied by a tour guide, visit the **city center** and its **cathedral**, a **jewel of Gothic art listed as a World Heritage Site**.

End your day with a **tasting workshop** featuring 3 champagnes with a specialist who will reveal some of the secrets of the Wine of Kings.

## **CHATEAU AND CAMILLE CLAUDEL MUSEUM JUST OURSIDE PARIS**

Valid: from Wednesday to Sunday

Go back in time to the 18th century in the corridors of the fully furnished Château de la Motte Tilly and its 60-hectare park labeled «remarkable garden» before having lunch in the historic center of Nogent-Sur-Seine. Understand in what artistic context Camille Claudel was trained, evolved and became asserted, that is the challenge of this visit to the first **Camille Claudel museum** in the world, in Nogent-sur-Seine, the city where, as a teenager, the artist met the sculptor Alfred Boucher in 1874.





### **CULTURE AND HERITAGE**

Last: 1 day
Distance: 0 km (whole program is based in Troyes)

Based on 30 people Valid: May to October From € 55 / person

Guided tour of the new **Musée d'Art Moderne de Troyes**. Nearly 2,000 paintings, sculptures, drawings, ceramics... offer a complete panorama of art from the second half of the 19th century to the 1960s, as well as a collection of primitive art from Africa and Oceania.

Local lunch with drinks in the heart of the city

Afternoon **guided tour of the historic center**. Immerse yourself in the historic capital of Champagne and discover the Saint-Jean-au Marché district, with its remarkable 16th-century timber-framed houses, medieval alleyways including the picturesque ruelle des chats, its secret courtyards and the church of Sainte-Madeleine, with its remarkable Renaissance rood screen of stone.

**Optional** visit to the **Marché des Halles** to buy local produce or sample Pascal Caffet chocolates, or stop off at the factory outlets of **Mc Arthur Glen** factory outlets. A hundred or so stores on nearly 30,000 m2 of floor space laid out like a village, with architecture inspired by the half-timbered houses in the historic heart of Troyes.





## **GASTRONOMY OF THE AUBE**

Last: 1 day
Distance: 51 km
Valid: May to October

Based on 30 people From € 63 / person

Guided tour of the **cider museum** with tasting of farm products and videorama retracing the making of cider, **discovery of orchards by a little train**. Departure for **Chaource** for a typical lunch with drinks at the restaurant. You'll continue with a visit to a **cheese dairy** to discover the traditional artisanal production (ladle molding) or the discovery of a **mushroom farm** with product tasting.

The day ends with a visit to a **champagne cellar** in Les Riceys, the only Champagne village to boast 3 AOCs (Champagne, Coteau champenois and Rosé des Riceys) to discover Louis XIV's favorite wine, **Rosé des Riceys**.



## PRESTIGE OF CHAMPAGNE AND CRISTAL

Last: 1 day Distance: 30 km Based on 20 people From € 52 / person

Valid : All year round

Morning: Start the day with a guided tour of the **Abbaye de Clairvaux**, founded in the 12th century by Saint-Bernard.

Lunch at Clairvaux Abbey or in a partner restaurant. (Menu includes aperitif, starter, main course, dessert, wine and coffee).

Afternoon: Take a self-guided tour of the **Musée du Cristal** in Bayel, which houses unique pieces (creations, tools...). This museum shows us the **manufacturing secrets**.

To round off your visit, watch a **glass-blowing demonstration**.

The day ends a few kilometers away with a guided tour of a **Champagne cellar** and a **tasting** session.

## **REIMS, CULTURE AND GASTRONOMY**

Visit the **Biscuiterie Fossier**, taste and buy in the shop. Created in 1691, Biscuit Rose de Reims is one of the jewels of the city. Always associated with champagne in the past, it is a symbol of the

festivities. Lunch in a restaurant, followed by a **guided tour of the city** with a visit of **Notre Dame de Reims Cathedral**, a Gothic masterpiece built in 1211. Heavily damaged during the First World War, it features an architectural feat: a reinforced concrete framework designed by architect Henri Deneux, and a rich array of contemporary stained-glass windows.

### Optional extension available:

Overnight in a 3\* hotel and dinner, day 2: Embark on a 3-hour **cruise** with **lunch** on the Champagne Vallée boat, along the Marne river, another vision of Champagne

# TROYES, EUROPEAN CAPITAL OF STAINED GLASS

Distance: All day by foot
Valid: All year round

**Guided tour of Troyes** to discover 9 centuries of **stained glass history**, from the Middle Ages to the present day, from the majesty of the cathedral to the astonishing stained-glass windows of the Basilique St Urbain. Then, at the foot of the Cathedral, visit the **Cellier St Pierre** for a guided tour of the **Prunelle de Troyes** distillery and tasting session.

**Lunch** at the restaurant.

Guided tour of the **Cité du Vitrail**, located at Hôtel-Dieu-le-Comte, to discover the exceptional wealth of stained glass in all its dimensions: historical, technical, aesthetic... and many masterpieces both ancient and contemporary. You'll finish with a free visit of the **Apothecary**, one of the most beautiful in France, in its original 18th-century setting.

# SCENTS AND DELIGHTS IN THE SEINE VALLEY

Last: 1 day Distance: 33 km Based on 40 people (20 people min.)

From € 56 / person

Valid: From Wednesday to Thursday

You'll start the day with a visit to the **Petite Biscuiterie Artisanale** in Maizières-la-Grande-Paroisse. You'll be able to taste the Maizièrons orange blossom, rum or even carrés d'Othe... to be eaten without moderation! Head for Romilly-Sur-Seine to discover the **Espace Vivant de la Bonneterie**, winding machines, elastic knitting, «Cachou» socks and the world's largest sock!

After your **local lunch in Nogent-sur-Seine**, you'll head to the **botanical garden** at Marnay-Sur-Seine for a digestive stroll. You stroll through the different parts of the garden: evolution path,

rose gardens, medicinal plants, condiment plants, vegetable garden, shade garden, conservatory garden, ornamental garden, green wall...





## THE TEMPLAR TREASURE

**Last :** 1 day (optional extension) **Distance :** 15 km

Based on 30 people From € 45 / person

(with extension : € 175 / person)

Valid: All year round

Guided tour of the **Musée Hugues de Payns**. Discover the forgotten history of the founder of the Order of the Temple, archaeological discoveries, the treasure of the Payns Knights Templar and their fabulous legends. Lunch in Old Troyes, followed by a guided tour of **Troyes, birthplace of the Knights Templar**. Discover Troyes **Cathedral**, the emblematic site where Bernard de Clairvaux had the Templar Order approved at the Council of 1128. Departure to Avalleur to visit the **Templar Commandery**, one of the few remaining in France.

#### Optional extension:

Overnight in a 3\* hotel and dinner, day 2: Guided tour of the **Maison de l'Outil et de la Pensée Ouvrière** which houses a collection of 18th- and 19th-century hand tools.





### **CHAMPAGNE BY BIKE**

Last: 3 days Distance: 110 km Valid: All year round Based on 20 people From € 430 / person

Star tour from **Epernay**. You'll arrive by car or train and settle into your hotel\*\*\* before walking to the **Mercier cellars**, crossing the Avenue de Champagne (Unesco).

**On day 2**, depart by bike for **Condé sur Marne** along the Véloroute de la Vallée de la Marne, along the canal, then return for a quick champagne lunch before a visit to **Pressoria**, followed by a tasting of 2 champagnes and return to Epernay.

**Day 3**: Cycle to **Dormans** on the Véloroute de la Vallée de la Marne then on to **Hautvillers** for a snack in a champagne bar. Free visit of the village where **Dom Pérignon** lived, then return to Epernay. End of program at 4:30pm. Bike rental, including helmet and lock, is included in the price.



## "GASTRONOMY & HISTORY» STAY IN THE AUBE

Last: 2 days Distance: 104 km

Based on 25 people From € 212 / person

Valid: All year round

Arrive in **Troyes** in the late morning, and enjoy lunch in a bistronomic restaurant. Guided tour of the Cité du Vitrail, a large-scale scientific, cultural, educational and tourist project, a place of discovery, emotion and experimentation, then free time in the city or at your hotel 3\*.

The following day, guided tour of the Musée de la Résistance de l'Aube, initially created in 1967 by members of the Mussy-Grancey F.F.I. maguis, the museum recalls the occupation of the département during the Second World War and the careers of Aube Resistance fighters. Lunch in a restaurant before a visit to the **Hennequière champagne cellar**, followed by a tasting of 2 champagne vintages, in the heart of the Vallée de la Sarce.





## "HERITAGE AND GASTRONOMY» STAY IN **CHAMPAGNE**

Last: 3 days Distance: 152 km Valid: All year round Based on 25 people From € 368 / person

On arrival in Troyes, you'll enjoy lunch in a bistronomic restaurant before discovering the fabulous city of Troyes on the theme of «stained glass masterpieces». Check-in, dinner and overnight at your hotel\*\*\*.

The following day visit to the Dosches windmill before lunch by the lake, followed by a guided tour aboard the "Bateau Ivre" boat. Return to Troyes for enjoy some free time, the Halles market is ideal for buying local chaource, andouillettes and Pascal Caffet chocolates! On last day you'll enjoy a guided tour of the Musée du Vauluisant (Musée Renaissance en Champagne and Musée de la Bonneterie), lunch in the heart of the historic area, then off to Montgueux to visit a Champagne cellar, followed by a tasting session.





## FROM THE CÔTE DES BAR TO LAC D'ORIENT

Last: 2 days Distance: 115 km Valid: From mid-march Based on 30 people From € 260 / person

to mid-September

This break combines nature and heritage. Discover the history of glass and crystal at the Musée du Cristal and watch a glass-blowing demonstration. Lunch at Clairvaux Abbey, followed by a guided tour. Before leaving for the hotel and its spa area, you'll make a stop at a winegrower's for a champagne tasting.

The next day, you'll embark on a cruise aboard the "bateau lvre" boat which will reveal all the secrets of this artificial lake. You'll have lunch on the shores of Lac d'Orient, then head off for a walk in the Orient Forest to discover its myths and legends (or visit a half-timbered church).





### ON THE ROADS OF AUBE EN CHAMPAGNE

Last: 4 days Distance: 126 km Valid: All year round Based on 25 people From € 508 / person

Rendez-vous in the heart of the Forêt d'Orient Regional Nature Park for a lunch overlooking the lake, then off to the timber-framed church of Longsols. Dinner and overnight in a 4\* hotel near Troyes.

The 2nd day will be devoted to visiting the city of Troyes and its main museums, the Cité du Vitrail and the Maison de l'Outil et de la Pensée Ouvrière, after a stroll through the Montgueux vineyards.

On the penultimate day, you'll discover the **Côte des Bar** and its champagne vineyards, lunch in a champagne cellar and a visit to the village of Essoyes, where the painter Pierre-Auguste Renoir lived. Finally, you'll round off your stay with a guided tour of the Cistercian abbey of Clairvaux and leave after a final lunch on site.

**DAY 1:** Arrival in **Reims** in the morning for a tour of the **Cathedral and the city center**. You'll discover the city closely linked to the coronation of the kings of France. After lunch in a typical Reims brasserie, you'll discover the **Gallo-Roman Crayères**, listed as a Unesco World Heritage Site, during a visit to a famous Champagne house. In the late afternoon, head for the **Montagne de Reims vineyards** to meet a **winemaker** who will explain all about the work in the vines. Dinner in the city center, overnight in a 3\* hotel.

**DAY 2:** Meet in **Châlons-en-Champagne** for a lunch in the city center before setting off to discover the Gallo-Roman cellars of **Joseph PERRIER champagne**. After a tasting of the king of wines, you'll take a **boat trip** and admire many sites and Chalonnais monuments from an unusual angle. Dinner downtown, overnight in 3\* hotel.

**DAY 3:** Off to Lac du Der for a visit to the **Musée du Der**, retracing the history of three villages that have disappeared and plunges you into the heart of an authentic Der village! After a local lunch, you'll discover the lake on board the **«au fil de l'eau» boat**. On your way to Troyes, you'll stop at Longsols to admire its **half-timbered church**. Dinner in downtown Troyes, overnight in a 3\* hotel.

**DAY 4:** Guided tour of **Troyes**, a city of art and history, which invites you to stroll around in a medieval atmosphere. Before lunch in the heart of the city, visit the Cellier St Pierre for a tour and tasting of **Prunelle de Troyes!** The afternoon is devoted to a visit to the **Maison de l'Outil et de la Pensée Ouvrière**, which houses a collection of tools from the 17th and 18th centuries.

After free time, dinner in the city center and overnight at your 3\* hotel.

**DAY 5:** Follow in the footsteps of **Pierre-Auguste Renoir** at Essoyes. Visit the Du Côté des Renoir center, the painter's studio, his home and the cemetery where he rests. Lunch, followed by a visit to the cellar, to discover one of **Renoir's champagnes!** Then on to the brand-new **Musée de la Résistance de l'Aube**, which recalls occupation of the département during the Second World War the Aube Resistance fighters, before returning to Troyes for dinner and your 3\* hotel.

**DAY 6:** Head for **Nogent-Sur-Seine** for a "Walk with Gustave Flaubert". A guided tour of the town to

discover the 19th-century Nogent that Gustave Flaubert knew when he visited his cousins, and which he used as the main setting of his novel L'Éducation sentimentale. Lunch in the heart of the city and guided tour of the **Camille Claudel Museum**. It was in Nogent-sur-Seine that Camille Claudel, as a teenager, affirmed her vocation as a sculptor when she lived there with her family. Today, some forty of her works are on display, making it the world's largest collection, enabling visitors to discover her artistic career.
